Strengths:

Tobi, overall a great game played at a low skill level (27 scrums in the second half for example). Your positioning was good with an excellent rapport with the players and you managed flashpoints well. 3 YCs all appropriately awarded. You were moving about the field well.

Coaching Advice

1. Tackle & Ruck

You have to decide who is at fault, is it the tacker not releasing, the tackled player holding on or the player on the wrong side. I felt on a few occasions you were penalising Valley for not releasing when the FC player had "fallen" on the wrong side and prevented a clean release. Perhaps Valley were holding on because they could not release? You may have YCed FC for persistent offending in the first half as they gave away 9 penalties in this area.

2. Scrum Resets

25% of scrums were reset and the vast majority were on the FC put in. It seemed that the Valley props (#5?) were acting illegally and certainly not binding some times. You have to ask the question "why are the Valley scrums not collapsing" during the match and take action. They all know how to keep a scrum up at this level.

3. Other

Watch the thrower to make sure the throw is in a forward direction, i.e. there should be no backward movement of the ball during the throw.

Watch the ball when it is taken back into the 22 (we all missed it!)

Keep vigilance up with the Line Out gaps - you started OK but it got a little untidy.

Signals were untidy and inconsistent - primary first and then secondary.
